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For the love of #lobsters we had dinner at Pince & Pints where that is all there is on the food menu. Three kinds, \$48 each. We liked best the whole grilled lobster served with a herbed butter sauce (really, what isn't better with butter) and then the lobster roll - a whole lobster, is stuffed into a top split pan-fried bun sourced from a traditional Chinatown bakery. There's also a lobster done chilli crab style which was a bit too sweet for us.
